

General Rules and Regulations

18.40 SMALL POWER RATE

AVAILABILITY

Available to commercial members, small industrial members, and farm members for all uses including lighting, appliances, cooking, heating, and motors, all subject to the established rules and regulations of the Association covering this service.

Service under this schedule is limited to members whose load requirements are 50 kVA or less. Members having their homes on the same premises with their business establishments may include service to both on the same meter, in which case the service will be classified as Commercial. A member may make provisions for two meters, in which case the usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule, and the usage for business purposes will be billed under this schedule and rate.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase and three-phase where available, 60 hertz with load requirements of 50 kVA or less, at available secondary voltages.

18.40 SMALL POWER RATE

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. The rated capacity of single-phase motors will not be in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) unless written approval is received from the Cooperative.
2. Normally, motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp or 10 kVA) must be three-phase.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, due and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month or \$5.00 per month whichever is greater will apply; service will be discontinued as determined by Rules and Regulations 12.0 Discontinuance of Service.

TAXES, FEES, ETC.

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those members receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.
