

General Rules and Regulations

**19.71 STREET LIGHTING – INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITIES RATE**

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**APPLICABILITY**

Applicable for street lighting service within the corporate limits of all incorporated municipalities, homeowner’s associations, and special districts under Colorado law, served by the Association.

**AVAILABILITY**

Available to all incorporated municipalities, homeowner’s associations and special districts that sign a one-year contract for lighting streets, alleys and parks for an unmetered photoelectric controlled lighting fixture at standard available voltage.

**RATE PER MONTH**

Each HID fixture rated at 175 watts, per month	\$ 15.40
Each LED fixture rated at 40 watts, per month	\$ 15.40
Each HID fixture rated at 250 watts, per month	\$ 27.65
Each HID fixture rated at 400 watts, per month	\$ 27.65
Each LED fixture rated at 70 watts, per month	\$ 27.65
Each additional transformer, per month	\$ 5.51
Each additional span of secondary not to exceed 150 feet, per month	\$ 5.51

**POWER COST ADJUSTMENT**

Power cost adjustment will be per month	\$ 0.00
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**EXTENSION, MAINTENANCE AND RELOCATION**

The Association, at its sole discretion and in accordance with sound engineering practices, will erect, build, and maintain, under normal wear and tear, the fixtures, poles, wiring and lamps used to render service under this rate.

Incorporated municipalities, homeowner’s associations and special districts requesting street lighting to be mounted on poles other than wood approved by Mountain View Electric Association Inc. (MVEA) or requesting underground street lighting distribution systems will be required to pay the Association, as a non-refundable contribution, an amount equal to the difference between the estimated cost of the requested system and that of the standard

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wood pole and overhead construction. In any event, all facilities will be installed, owned, operated, and maintained by the Association.

The Association will not be required to replace or repair broken lamps or fixtures when such breakage is due to excessive willful or negligent acts other than the Associations'.

The expense of relocating the fixtures after initial installations will be borne by the incorporated municipalities, homeowner's associations, and special districts.

### **NOTIFICATION OF MALFUNCTIONS**

It is the responsibility of the incorporated municipalities, homeowner's associations, and special districts to notify the Association of any burned out lamps or improper operation of the fixture. Repairs will be scheduled during regular working hours of the Association as set forth in the Rules and Regulations.

### **TERMS OF PAYMENT**

The above rates are net, due and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month or \$5.00 per month whichever is greater will apply; service will be discontinued as determined by Rules and Regulations 12.0 Discontinuance of Service.

### **TAXES, FEES, ETC.**

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those members receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.



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
