General Rules and Regulations

20.41 SCHRIEVER SPACE FORCE BASE RATE

AVAILABILITY

Available only to Schriever Space Force Base in El Paso County, Colorado.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Three-phase, 60 Hertz, at 115,000 Volts.

RATES AND CHARGES

The monthly rate will consist of the Energy Accounting and Billing Charge, the Maintenance Recovery Charge, the Demand Rate Component, and the Energy Rate Component as defined below.

Energy Accounting and Billing Charge, per month	\$321.00
Maintenance Recovery Charge, per month	\$1,850.00

DEMAND RATE COMPONENT

The monthly Peak Period Kilowatt (kW) Demand per month will be adjusted to coincide with Tri-State's wholesale demand rates charged to the Association using the following formula:

Demand Charge = $WD/(1-M)$; where WD = Wholesale Demand Rate, M = Margins = .07

The member's peak period demand will be based on the thirty (30) minute integrated kW demand period established by the member during the peak period as recorded by a demand meter during the Association's coincident peak period from 1:00 PM through 9:00 PM, Monday through Saturday, with the exception of New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

ENERGY RATE COMPONENT

The monthly Energy Charge will be adjusted to coincide with Tri-State's wholesale demand rates charged to the Association using the following formula:

Energy Charge = $WE/(1-M)$; where WE = Wholesale Energy Rate, M = Margins = .07

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

The maintenance recovery charge will be equal to the Association's expenses required to operate and maintain the facilities located in Schriever Space Force Base Substation. The monthly maintenance recovery charge will include a margin component of cost equal to the "M" value defined in the paragraphs above.

At the end of each calendar year, the Association will prepare a reconciliation of the maintenance costs with the amount charged over the preceding twelve (12) months. The difference between the amount charged and the reconciled amount will be amortized over the next twelve (12) months' billing.

20.41 SCHRIEVER SPACE FORCE BASE RATE

Any additional charge imposed upon the Association by Tri-State due to the member's failure to maintain a power factor at the point of delivery between ninety-five percent (95%) lagging and ninety-five percent (95%) leading will be passed on to the member.

Any additional charge imposed upon the Association by Tri-State due to the wheeling losses, transmission, wheeling, and ancillary services costs will be passed on to the member.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, due, and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month or \$5.00 per month, whichever is greater, will apply; service will be discontinued as determined by Rules and Regulations 12.0 Discontinuance of Service.

TAXES, FEES, ETC.

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those members receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.
