General Rules and Regulations

22.55 COLORADO CENTRE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT LIGHTING RATE

APPLICABILITY

Applicability for existing street lighting service for the Colorado Centre Metropolitan Service District served by the Association.

AVAILABILITY

Available to the Colorado Centre Metropolitan Service District for existing boulevard lighting for a 400 watt high pressure sodium unmetred photoelectric controlled lighting fixture at the standard available voltage.

RATE PER MONTH

Recovery of purchase price of facilities for each street light structure	\$45.22
Margins, taxes, operation and maintenance, cost of power, bulb replacement for each street light structure	\$41.23
Total per street light structure	\$86.44

EXTENSION, MAINTENANCE, AND RELOCATION

The Association, at its sole discretion and in accordance with sound engineering practices, will maintain, under normal wear and tear, the fixtures, poles, and wiring used to render service under this rate.

No future extensions under this rate shall be made.

The Association will not be required to replace or repair broken lamps or fixtures when such breakage is due excessive willful or negligent acts other than the Association's.

The expense of moving or relocating the fixtures after initial installations will be borne by the Colorado Centre Metropolitan Service District.

NOTIFICATION OF MALFUNCTIONS

It is the responsibility of the Colorado Centre Metropolitan Service District to notify the Association of burned-out lamps or any improper operation of the fixture. Repairs will be scheduled during regular working hours of the Association as set forth in the Rules and Regulations.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, due, and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month or \$5.00 per month, whichever is greater, will apply; service will be discontinued as determined by Rules and Regulations 12.0 Discontinuance of Service.
