General Rules and Regulations

16.02 RESIDENTIAL TIME-OF-DAY RATE

AVAILABILITY

Available to single family residential and members as defined in Rate 16.01 Residential Demand Rate.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase 60-hertz with load requirements of 50 kVA or less at available secondary voltages.

RATES AND CHARGES

Grid Access, per month	\$39.50
On-Peak Energy, per kWh, Monday – Friday* 5PM-9PM	\$0.34500
Off-Peak Energy, per kWh	\$0.08625
Power Cost Adjustment, per kWh	\$0.00

*Excluded holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day

Minimum Monthly Charge per Meter	\$39.50
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POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) may be adjusted from time to time to reflect variations in costs associated with providing electric service, as determined by the Association.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, due, and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month or \$5.00 per month, whichever is greater, will apply; service will be discontinued as determined by Rules and Regulations 12.0 Discontinuance of Service.

TAXES, FEES, ETC.

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those members receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.

CHANGES

Members may elect or change their applicable rate schedule at any time for their initial rate selection. Following the initial election, members shall be required to remain on the selected rate schedule for a minimum of twelve (12) months before requesting a subsequent rate change.
