General Rules and Regulations

16.07 NON-METERED RESIDENTIAL TEMPORARY RATE

AVAILABILITY

Available to single family residential defined as follows:

Any single private home that is currently under construction. Members must convert to a standard residential rate before a Certificate of Occupancy is issued.

This service is offered for a maximum of twelve (12) months and may be discontinued at the end of said 12-month period.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase 60-hertz with load requirements of 25 kVA or less at available secondary voltages.

RATES AND CHARGES

Single-Phase Grid Access, per month	\$39.50
Flat rate based on average 200 kWh per month	\$28.91
Power Cost Adjustment, per kWh	\$0.00

Minimum Monthly Charge per Meter	\$68.41
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POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) may be adjusted from time to time to reflect variations in costs associated with providing electric service, as determined by the Association.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

The rated capacity of single-phase motors will not be more than ten horsepower (10 hp) unless written approval is received from the Cooperative.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, due, and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month or \$5.00 per month, whichever is greater, will apply; service will be discontinued as determined by Rules and Regulations 12.0 Discontinuance of Service.

TAXES, FEES, ETC.

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those members receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.
