General Rules and Regulations

17.12 MUNICIPAL WATER PUMPING RATE

AVAILABILITY

Available to municipalities, water districts, or individuals for the purpose of supplying domestic water to the ultimate consumer as part of a public water system.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase and three-phase at available voltages.

RATES AND CHARGES

Grid Access, per month	\$109.15
Energy, per kWh	\$0.05439
On-Peak Demand, per kVA, Monday – Friday* 5PM-9PM	\$12.00
Demand, per kVA	\$6.09
Power Cost Adjustment, per kWh	\$0.00

*Excluded holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand will be the maximum 15-minute integrated kVA demand established by the member during the billing period as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) may be adjusted from time to time to reflect variations in costs associated with providing electric service, as determined by the Association.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge will be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the member in question:

The minimum charge specified for the contract for service	
A charge per kVA of installed transformer capacity	\$1.50
A charge of	\$127.50

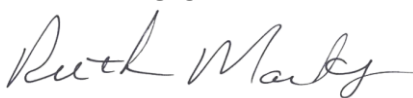
CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

The rated capacity of single-phase motors will not be in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) unless written approval is received from the Association.

All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point will be considered the distribution system of the wholesale member and will be furnished and maintained by the wholesale member.

The member will comply with and be bound by the Association's lawful rules, regulations, and bylaws as the same may be amended from time to time.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

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The above rates are net, due, and payable on or before the date stated on the bill. If not paid on or before this date, a late charge of 2% per month or \$5.00 per month, whichever is greater, will apply; service will be discontinued as determined by Rules and Regulations 12.0 Discontinuance of Service.

TAXES, FEES, ETC.

Any tax, franchise fee, or other similar charge, however denominated, will be recovered by a surcharge only upon those members receiving service within the boundaries of the district and/or municipality imposing such tax or fee.



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
